- Review and update website
- Other communications and social media activities
- Support the Campaigns and Communications Officer with social media, including Twitter, Instagram and Facebook.

Is there induction and training?

Yes, we provide an induction to all new volunteers. This covers roles and responsibilities, safeguarding, and other important aspects.

You will be provided with the training needed to perform the role and will have the opportunity to join training with the whole LRMN team.
